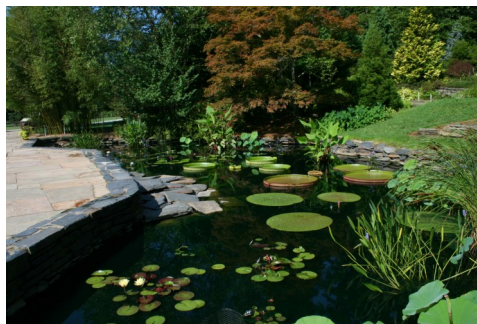
Bikeability
