## E-Safety

Keeping safe online is incredibly important to all of us and over the year we have shared information about how to keep your children safe. We have been made aware that some young children have been playing a game called Fortnite. Within this game there are voice and text chat systems which are leaving children open to being contacted by strangers. Research by the charity NSPCC suggests that 25% of children that have played the game have been contacted by a stranger. The game has an age rating of 12 years so none of our children are likely to be using it but if you know that your child has access to this game you will no doubt want to put restrictions on this to ensure their safety.
