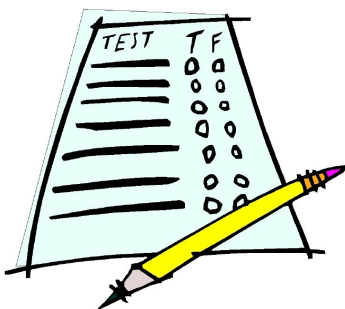
## Year 3/4 Football Tournament
